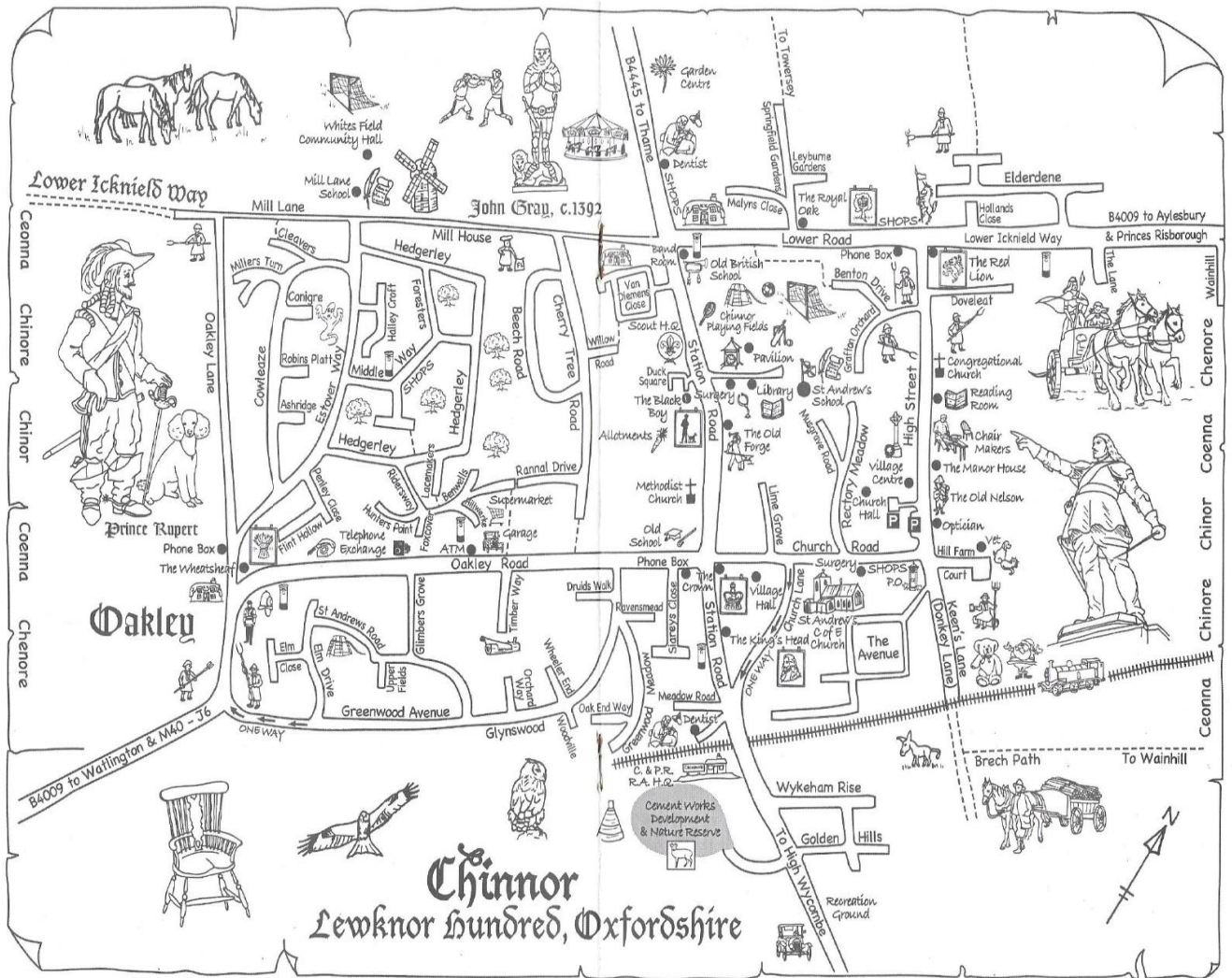


Children's Quiz
